Connexions Personal Advisors

Every young person aged 13 - 19 within this area has a personal advisor who offers friendly advice on a number of issues. They can also offer help and advise to:

- School non-attenders
- Young people not in training, education or employment
- Young people with substance misuse problems
- Young offenders
- Teenage parents
- Care leavers
- Black and minority young people
- Asylum seekers
- Young people with disabilities including learning difficulties

Education Welfare Officers

Officers are there to help you if you're having problems which are making it difficult for you to attend school. They can help you to sort out any problems such as bullying, boredom, pressures from your friends or problems with schoolwork and offer you free independent advice. They can help you to talk to your parents or teachers and make it easier for you to get back to school and feel happier about it.
