Drug dealers fuel crime and ruin lives.

Help us to come down hard on them by giving us names and information on any drug dealing in your area.

Possible signs of drug dealing:

- High number of visitors to one property
- Visitors stopping for short periods
- Individuals approaching parked cars for very short periods
- * Drug litter (eg. needles and syringes) found close to suspected location
- Excessive noise or rowdy incidents near the suspected location

When you ring it would be helpful if you could provide us with any of the following information:

- Names and addresses of those involved
- Where you suspect the dealing is taking place
- The reasons for your suspicions
- Car registration numbers
- Any other information you think would be useful
